Yogi Ji grew up in a traditional Hindu family in a small village in Dang, in the western part of Nepal. At the age of seven he left the warmth of his parents' home and traveled to Delhi for his education. After eight years in Delhi he returned to Nepal. At age 21 he began his interest in social work with *Hindu Vidya-Peeth* (HVP), a charity-based institution that imparts modern education along with spiritual values.

Over the years Yogi Ji has started a number of service organizations including *Shanti Sewa Ashram*, (SSA) an organization working for the promotion of spirituality through selfless service in collaboration with 21 different organizations. He also works with *Youth Society for Peace* which acts as a forum for youth committed to peace and service. Yogi Ji has dedicated his life to peace in service to humanity.
